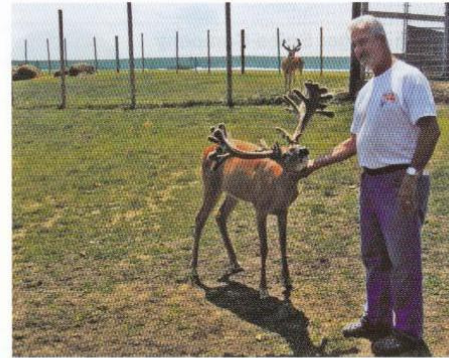

Pennsylvania is a leading state for deer farming, second only to Texas in the entire country.

After a life of avid hunting, Roco Sloboda made the decision to raise whitetail deer instead of cows or horses for his retirement project. Roco started with only four deer and now has over 100 whitetails in his herd. Thirty acres of his 400-acre farm are devoted to raising deer.

At Fantasy Whitetail Deer Farm, does are selectively bred with renown bucks. Breeding takes place in November each year. The newly-born fawns live in pens separate from the deer herd. The whitetail deer self-feed from troughs, and plenty of water is available.

Guests to this unique farm are requested to be extremely quiet while viewing the whitetail deer on the day of the tour. Owner Roco Sloboda will be available to answer your questions. Directions will be provided for the other two stops on the Butler County Farm Tour.

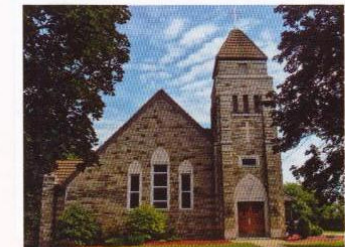

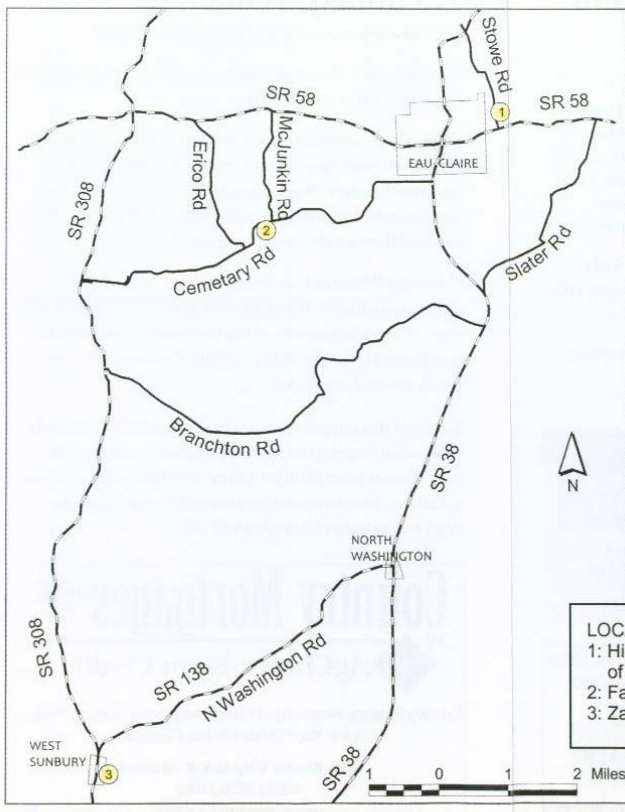

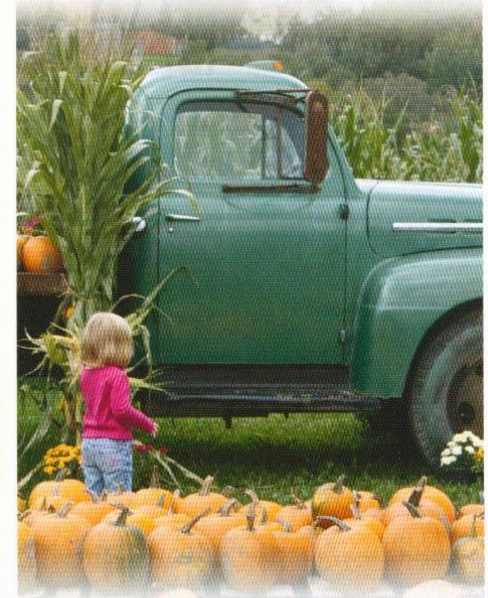
